



COURSE TERMS & CONDITIONS

Prerequisites

- 12 years of age
- Able to swim 200m non-stop and tread water for 10mins
- Medically fit to dive (see medical statement)

Medical Statement

Please ensure you have read the medical statement on our website before booking your course. If you answer “yes” to any of the questions, you may be required to obtain a recreational dive medical. This can usually be done with your GP (you will need to check with your GP first).

Liability Release & Assumption of Risk Agreement

All PADI Courses worldwide have standard documentation which includes a liability release. Please read before booking your PADI Open Water Course.

All course paperwork can be completed through the PADI portal once enrolled.

Course Transfers (Change of dates/students/Bookings)

PADI eLearning materials are assigned to individuals and are non-transferable between students.

Change of course dates are free of charge until 14 days before the start date.

The following fees apply for course transfers:

- \$100 fee within 14 days
- \$200 fee within 7 days

Course cancellation with more than 14 days will only incur the costs of eLearning materials.

Course cancellations within 14 days will incur the full cost of the course.

PADI Dive Certification

PADI courses are performance-based. You pay for the course and then earn the certification under the guidance of our instructor.
